

## **GRANDMOTHER OF PLAZA DE MAYO DECORATED BY SWEDISH GOVERNMENT DURING HOMAGE TO RAOUL WALLENBERG**

The President of Grandmothers of Plaza de Mayo, Estela Barnes de Carlotto, received a decoration from the Swedish Embassy during the celebrations for the centenary of the birth of Raoul Wallenberg, a Swedish diplomat who tirelessly fought to save thousands of Hungarian Jews from the Holocaust during World War II.

The homage to Wallenberg was held on the premises of the Argentine Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Worship, and it was organized jointly by said Ministry, the Embassy of the Kingdom of Sweden and the International Raoul Wallenberg Foundation.

After a short film on the life of the Swedish diplomat, Paul Levine, a senior lecturer at Uppsala University, offered a presentation on this human rights advocate.
